Sending official acceptance letters by email (**June** or October).

Rama B: Clases en Español

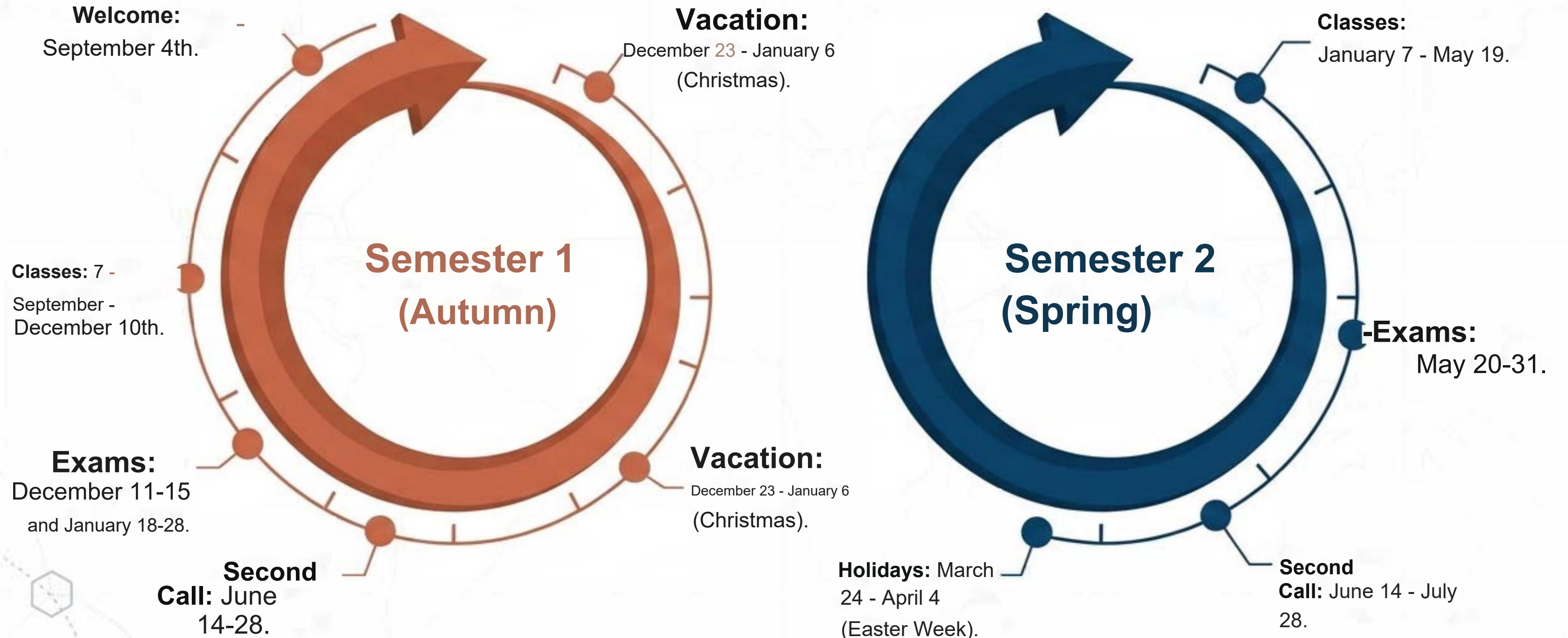


No official certificate is required.

Accommodation



Residences University students

Main option: Colegio Mayor "Pedro Cerbuna" (20 min walk from Gran Vía).

Warning: Extremely high demand. Book immediately upon receiving your acceptance letter (relint@unizar.es). Very limited places available.



Floors Shared

The most popular option for cultural immersion.

Conditions: Requires 1-2 months' deposit in advance.

Recommended areas: City Center, Cuéllar, Plaza Roma, University.



Accommodation Temporary

For your first few days: Baltasar Gracián Youth Hostel.

Strategy: Book a week here while you visit potential apartments in person.

Calculate your estimated monthly budget

Grand Total: Between €500 and €800 per month depending on your lifestyle.

Advantage: Zaragoza maintains a significantly lower cost of living than major capitals such as Madrid or Barcelona, while maintaining a high quality of life.

Tip: Shared flats dramatically reduce the cost barrier compared to private residences.

Ask your 'Buddy' for help in assessing fair areas and prices.



Easily resolve your practical and legal procedures .



1. Immigration and Permits

EU/Norway/Switzerland citizens must register at the Foreigners' Office if their stay exceeds 3 months.

Non-EU citizens must obtain their visa at the Spanish Embassy before flying.

FECEM will give you an Erasmus certificate for this procedure.



2. Medical Coverage

It is strictly mandatory to have coverage throughout your stay.

You can use the European Health Insurance Card (Public Health) or take out equivalent private insurance.



3. Local Integration (Buddy Programme)

You will be assigned a local FECEM student.


Your 'Buddy' will contact you after the welcome meeting to guide you through your first few days in the city.

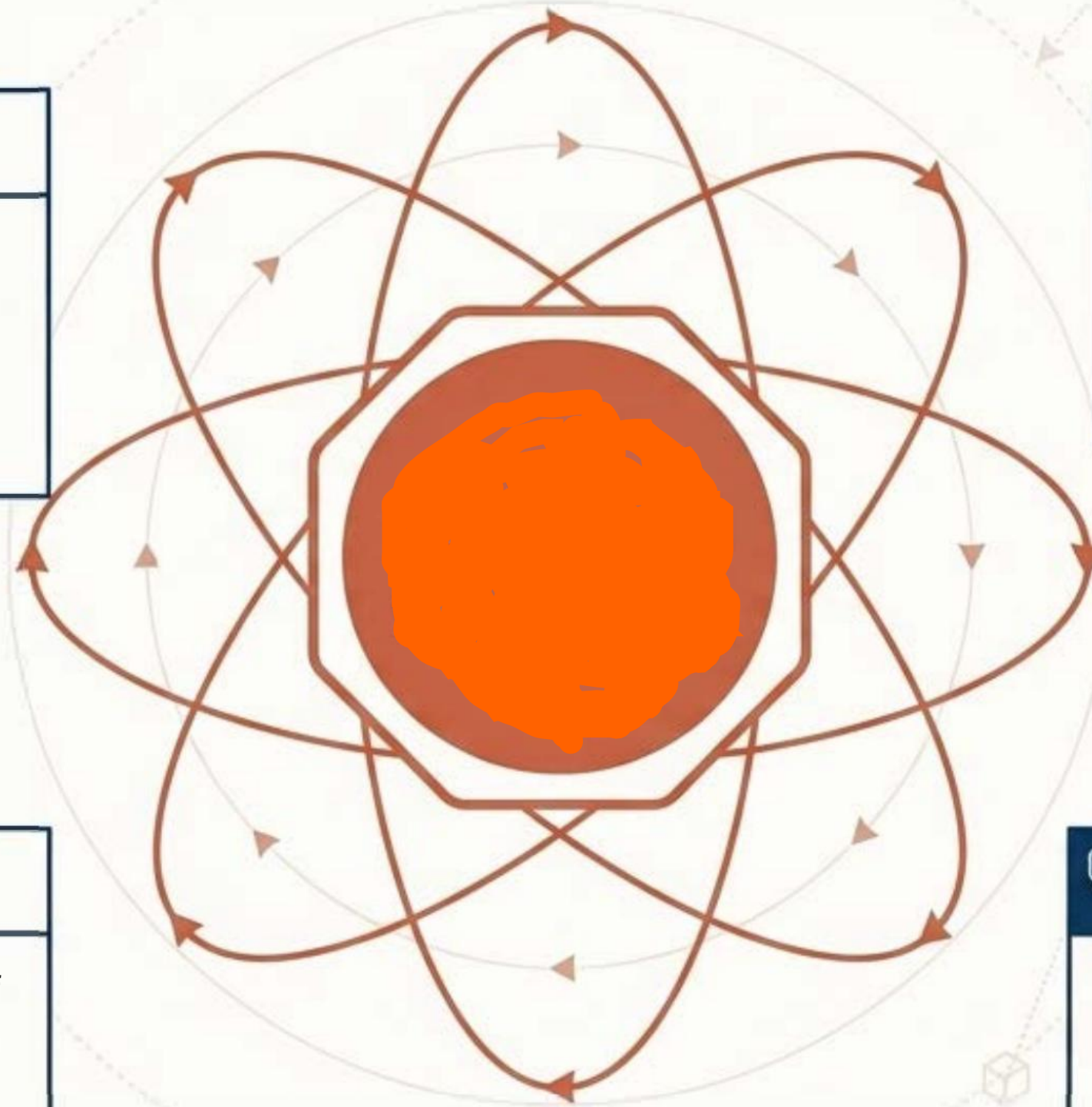
